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<u>Headmaster Letter</u>

Dear Archway Family and Friends,

Mondays. To be honest, I have not always looked forward to the first day of the work week. This year, though, Mondays mark a special day on my calendar, a classroom day. On Mondays I devote a significant portion of the day to being in the classroom - sitting at a desk beside a student, walking the hallways, eating lunch in the cafeteria - observing the act of education. As a leader, I desire to craft and care for our school culture, and firsthand experiences from the classroom provide me with the knowledge necessary to do so wisely (or at least that's the hope).

Can I share with you a few of my observations from this week? For those who said, "yes," the following paragraphs are for you.

Now that the intercom is working properly in grades 5-6, I led the Pledge of Allegiance and Expectations of an Argonaut from one of the sixth grade classrooms. Stepping into an adjacent classroom, I had to watch my step because the room was filled with models of a cell which the students had completed. One of the models represented a washing machine, complete with an electrical outlet! The teacher informed me, "I just want to cancel class the rest of the day, so that I can admire their projects!"

Later in the morning I observed a math class. Three dresses each cost the same amount. Because they cost the same amount, a bar model could be constructed to

visually see that once the change had been given from \$100, a student could know how much each dress cost. Several students showed their work under the document camera for all to see. Later the teacher told me, "I love teaching bar models." That was evident from being in the room. By the way, each dress cost \$28.

In the afternoon I visited a first grade class which had been studying geography. Around the perimeter of the room student work was displayed, declaring that "A compass rose is a symbol on a map that shows the direction." The neatness of the handwriting rivaled my own. From there I joined a kindergarten class in which the teacher was reading *Charlotte's Web*. Some of our faculty had just discussed that classic in my living room the day before. I eagerly asked the teacher if I could read a page or two, so I read the section about what Wilbur ate for lunch, leading up to the miracle of "SOME PIG."

Each day at Archway North Phoenix the miracle of education unfolds. In some ways it is a miracle, but in other ways it is a testament to the dedication and perseverance of teachers and students alike. Thank you for allowing me to share a glimpse into the classroom. Experiences like these make Mondays merry.


Message from a parent



NEW Birthday Policy

The new school policy is that birthday treats, toys, goodies, or "thank you" notes may NOT be distributed at school by parents, students, or teachers. Invitations may be distributed at school as long as the entire class is invited or if all the boys or all the girls of a class are invited. If invitations are not inclusive as indicated, then invitations will not be distributed. Students may choose to purchase a book from the school's "wish list" (archwaynorthphoenix.greatheartsacademies.org - click on Academics tab, Literature Reading Lists, and the appropriate grade level) to donate to the school library in honor of their birthday. A parent may arrange to read the book with the birthday student in front of the class. We know that birthdays are special, so will we do our best to make your child feel special on his/her special day.

Dress Code

After a two-week grace period during which warnings were communicated and emails were sent home, on Monday, August 20, uniform infractions began being issued for students out of dress code. If a student receives a total of three infractions within a thirty-day period or five infractions within a quarter, they are required to serve a detention.
