## **Headmaster Letter**

Dear Archway Family and Friends,

"That's a real Monet," I remember saying to myself as I stood in Hall 14 of the Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts in Moscow. This farm boy from Iowa was standing, mouth agape, in front of *Haystack at Giverny*. I was familiar with *Haybale at Knoxville*, but in that moment I was overcome by the Beauty of Monet's brushstrokes displayed on the wall in front of me. I could have stretched out my arm and felt the contours that the oil had made on the canvas, but, of course, I refrained (partly because the Russian babushkas who protect the art can be a little intimidating). The next hall housed the Cezannes, and the next the Van Goghs. I felt like I had won a cultural lottery to be allowed to stand in this sacred space, viewing some of the finest masterpieces known to humankind. I thought, "Everyone should be able to experience this."



Over winter break our school underwent a transformation. Nearly fifty replicas of fine art now adorn our hallways, causing one of our faculty to remark, "It feels like I now work in a museum." Our fifth and sixth graders can admire Monet's impression of a sun rise across from the drinking fountains on their floor. Third graders can observe Cezanne's *Still Life with Apples and Oranges* near their classrooms, and Van Gogh's

*Iris* and *Starry Night* greet all who enter the second-floor lobby.

In the first-floor lobby, an eight-foot tall Jason stands in the prow of the Argo. The ship's builder, Argus, is seen attaching an oak timber from Dodona, preparing the ship to launch into sea, destined for Colchis. The mission of the voyage was to fetch the Golden Fleece and return to Iolcus. Those courageous men who joined Jason's crew on the journey were perhaps the strongest and bravest band of heroes ever assembled and came to be known as the Argonauts.



At Archway North Phoenix we are

assembling a crew of courageous young scholars who are pursuing Truth, Goodness, and Beauty amidst a society that is often pursuing Possessions, Pleasure, and Power. Ours is a higher calling, and the going will not be easy. There will be waves of public opinion that will attempt to knock us off course, and perils of the urgent that will threaten our resolve. However, our teachers, our scholars - our crew - will be daily greeted by Jason and reminded of the perseverance required to accomplish that which is noble.

Thank you for making this happen. It is only through your generosity as parents and the direction provided by PSO that this art project came to realization. As scholars returned to class yesterday, their gait slowed, mesmerized by the gaze of the *Lady with a Pearl Earring*. They paused to study Matisse's *Goldfish* and marveled at Rembrandt's mastery of light and shadow in *The Night Watch*. One student commented to his brother, "Look at this one! I want it for my room." Another remarked, "Isn't the art beautiful! It's too bad they couldn't afford the originals." Too bad, indeed. Nonetheless, everyone should have the experience of being surrounded by Beauty.
