Headmaster Letter

Dear Archway Family and Friends,

Over the course of my adult life I have travelled to nearly twenty-five different countries. There are only two continents that I have not visited - Australia (on my bucket list) and Antarctica (not so much). Moscow holds a special place in my heart because that is the city where I courted the woman who became my wife. Nice remains one of my favorite places in the world. The jewel of the French Riviera is where Mme. Fee and I began our married life. Singapore is this

wonderful blend of Chinese, Malay, Indian, and Arab sights, sounds, and smells all located on the same English-speaking island. And clean. Did I mention how much I thoroughly enjoyed how clean Singapore was? Through these travels I have come to appreciate how blessed I am to be an American. Our country is not perfect, but it is still one of the greatest countries in the world and a hopeful beacon of liberty for many.

In a nation plagued by political division and strife, I make an appeal for patriotism - not a patriotism that is naive or sectarian, but a patriotism that calls us to what is Good and noble in each of us as fellow citizens. I am reminded of John Stuart Mill's letters. Mill, a nineteenth-century British philosopher, makes his case for patriotism in the schoolhouse:

"The young people of this country are not to be regenerated by economic doctrine or economic history or physical science; they can only be elevated by ideas which act upon the imagination and act upon the character and influence of the soul, and it is the function of all good teachers to bring those ideas before them.

"I have sometimes heard it said that you should not teach patriotism in the school. I dissent from that doctrine. I think that patriotism should be taught in the schools. I will tell you what I mean by patriotism. By patriotism I do not mean Jingoism, but what I mean by patriotism is an intelligent appreciation of all things noble in the romances, in the literature, and in the history of one's own country. Young people should be taught to admire what is great while they are at school. ...

"I say that I want patriotism in the larger sense of the term taught in the schools. Of course, there is a great deal to criticize in any country, and I should be the last person to suggest that the critical faculty should not be exercised and trained at school. But before we teach children to criticize the institutions of their country, before we teach them to be critical of what is bad, let us teach them to recognize and admire what is good. After all life is very short; we all of us have only one life to live, and during that life let us get into ourselves as much love, as much admiration, as much elevating pleasure as we can, and if we view education merely as discipline in critical bitterness, then we shall lose all the sweets of life and we shall make ourselves unnecessarily miserable. There is quite enough sorrow and hardship in this world as it is without introducing it prematurely to young people."

At Archway North Phoenix we pursue with purpose what is Good and that includes what is Good about the country we share as our

home.



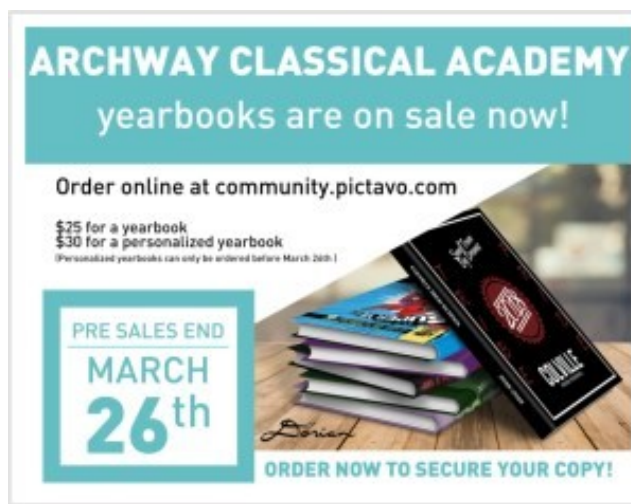
