Dear Archway Families and Friends,

As part of our read-a-thon, ANP conducted its first ever book drill today as we continue to encourage our students to engage in reading.

The funds raised during our read-a-thon will be used toward our library and librarian. I particularly remember one of my librarians, Mrs. Williams. She knew I was a fan of the Hardy Boys mysteries. I had read every adventure of Frank and Joe and had even considered naming my firstborn son Chester, after their affable friend, Chet. Mrs. Williams, the good librarian that she was, also knew my reading level. When I approached her desk with The Secret of Wildcat Swamp (Book 39 in the Hardy Boys series), she looked at me and said, "Really, Curtis? Let me show you something." She walked me over to a section of the library that had thick books where she pulled A Study in Scarlet off the shelf.

"Arthur Conan Doyle," I asked. "Who is he?" I quickly found out who Arthur Conan Doyle was as well as Sherlock Holmes and Watson. After finishing Doyle's works, I asked Mrs. Williams, "What's next?" She introduced me to Agatha Christie and her detective, Hercule Poirot. I continued to read Christie's works into adulthood, having the pleasure of reading Death on the Nile, while actually sailing on the Nile.

Our hope is that our library and eventual librarian at ANP can connect our scholars to books that they enjoy and that will stretch them in their ability to read great literature. 
