School Day and Calendar

Start and Dismissal times

The doors will open at 7:30 a.m., and classes will begin at 8:00 a.m. We recommend that you arrive on campus **by 7:45** so that your student can unpack and be completely ready for instruction by 8:00 a.m. Doors to the MPR will close promptly at 8:00, after which time parents will need to sign their children in at the front office. **Please keep in mind that there is no supervision provided for students prior to 7:30 a.m.** so children should remain in the vehicle with their parents until drop-off procedures begin.

Classes for all grades (K-6) will conclude at 3:00 p.m. All students not picked up **by 3:30 p.m.** are subject to a fee of \$1/minute.

There will be early dismissal every **Wednesday at 1:45 p.m.** The first day of school is a Wednesday, so please remember the dismissal time is at 1:45.

First Day of Kindergarten and Cheers and Tears

On Tuesday, August 6 we invite our Kindergarten parents to walk your scholars to the classroom beginning at 7:40 a.m., take a few pictures, and then join us in the MPR for Cheers and Tears from 8:00-9:00. During this time you will hear from the Headmaster, the Academy Giving Manager, and from a first-grade parent. You will also have the opportunity to congratulate and console fellow kindergarten parents! At 12:00 ALL kindergarten students (both full-day and half-day) will be dismissed through the dismissal process (do not park your car on campus), and you will get to hear all about their exciting first day!

Meet the Teacher

Meet the Teacher will take place on **Monday**, **August 5th**, **from 3:00-6:00 p.m.** Families will be greeted in the multi-purpose room (MPR) on the north side of campus. As in the past, families will have the opportunity to settle expenses for textbook consumables and receive their student's class/teacher assignments.

Drop-off and Dismissal

There is very little visitor parking to allow parents to walk their child safely to the entrance. We ask that parents drop off their children by car at the north end of campus, where they will be guided into the multi-purpose room (MPR) and their classroom by ANP faculty. Any parents walking their children onto campus will be asked to say their good-byes at the MPR doors. Parents will not be allowed to



walk into the hallways, playground area, or check in at the front office to walk students to the classroom. Please be assured that we are utilizing all ANP faculty to make the drop-off procedure successful, and we will make sure that students get to their classrooms safely.

We **do not have permission** to park in the adjacent business properties, including the Elks Lodge north of campus and the Paradise Valley Baptist Church south of campus. We ask that you please respect our neighbors' property.

<u>2019-20 ANP Uniform and Dress Code</u>

Dress Code

In an effort to provide greater clarity, we wanted to provide better definition regarding some of the language in the family handbook about the dress code expectations for girls. The handbook reads "Neat small bows, barrettes, headbands, and hair ties are permissible so long as they coordinate with the uniform." For our purposes small means not greater than 5 inches x 2.5 inches. The colors that coordinate with the uniform are limited to white, blue, navy blue, light blue, and burgundy. The patterns that coordinate with the uniform are limited to solid, stripes, polka dots, and plaid. We hope this alleviates

some of the confusion caused by ambiguity and will bring a clearer understanding of what is permissible.
