Headmaster letter:



Dear Archway Family and Friends,

It was great to see you on Monday during our Meet the Teacher event. I enjoyed hearing about your summer experiences and to witness the excitement as scholars discovered their teacher for the year and then scanned the list to find friends as fellow classmates. On the whole, it seemed that the children were eager to get back to school, and a few parents thanked me profusely because the parents were beyond ready for school to start for their scholars!

On Tuesday morning we welcomed the Class of 2032 to Archway North Phoenix. The kindergarten parents took pictures of their anxiously smiling scholars by the Great Hearts North Phoenix logo on the north wall of the campus. I greeted them with a handshake and an assurance of a wonderful

day ahead.

Once the scholars had made their way to their desks and were in the capable hands of their kindergarten teachers, the parents gathered in the MPR for Tears and Cheers (and there were both). From a Headmaster perspective, I shared with them the A-B-C's for a successful kindergarten year.

A- Attitude. Children learn by observing and imitation. Scholars frequently adopt the same attitude toward their teacher and their school that they witness in the car or in the home. One of the most significant factors of success is when children have a positive attitude toward their education, an attitude which they have developed because of what their parents have modeled.

B- Books. We are a Great Books school and love reading. We encourage and foster a love of great literature early and often. When children observe reading in the home and know that their parents are reading and reading to them, it sets them up for a lifetime of learning. [On a side note, some of our faculty are currently reading Great Gatsby, and we invite you to do so as well as part of the ANP learning community.]

C- Chores. Last week we had Larry Kirby from the Love and Logic Institute speak to our faculty and staff about an approach for engaging with children respectfully and helping scholars rightly understand the impact of their choices. During our time together, Mr. Kirby shared with me the strong correlation between children who do regular chores at home and their success in the classroom. I encouraged our kindergarten parents to assist their scholars in forming those good habits of personal responsibility and group citizenship through household chores.

Thank you for partnering with Archway North Phoenix and helping cultivate the hearts and minds of your scholars through the pursuit of Truth, Goodness, and Beauty. We look forward to the upcoming year!

CLUB DRAMA:

<u>*Club Drama*</u> for 4th - 6th grade students will have **40 available spots** to fill for open auditions that will begin September 5th, continuing September 12th, 2019, from 3:30-4:30 p.m.

This is not registration for Club Drama, but merely an opportunity to audition. Once auditions are completed, we will cast students in roles for our 2019-2020 production. At that time you will be asked to register your child and pay the club fees.

Club Drama 4th - 6th grades will begin earlier this year starting in September and will end with the performances at the beginning of May. As such, it is approximately an academic year commitment to Club Drama. The rehearsals will be on Thursdays from 3:30-4:30 p.m. with additional rehearsals added for half and full dress towards the end of April. Please take time to consider your child's ability to commit to the club 100% before signing them up for an audition.

The club fees will be \$200 which will cover the entire year. We are hoping this approach to auditions will make it more accessible to a larger population of students who are interested. If you need special payment arrangements, please speak to Mrs. English, office manager.

Drop Off/ Dismissal

Thank you for your patience during our first week of drop off and dismissal.

AM Drop Off - Time frame for Drop-Off is 7:30 a.m. - 7:59 a.m. If you arrive in the loading zone at 8:00, your student will be late. There has been a 5 minutes of grace period during drop off for the first week of school. Starting on Monday, 8/12/19 we will direct families who arrive in the Archway Loading Zone (where we let students out of cars) after 7:59 a.m. to park their car and accompany their student to the front office to sign in their student(s).

Typically, from the time you enter the campus till the time you exit the campus will take 10-15 minutes. Please arrive on campus with ample amount of time to allow your student(s) to get out of your car, into their classroom, unpack, and ready to start a calm and scholarly day.

PM Dismissal - M,T,TH,F - 3:00 p.m. Dismissal; W - 1:45 p.m. Dismissal. Please make sure you have your blue card clearly displayed on the dash of your windshield for the receivers to enter your family name into the system. If you do not have a blue card, we will ask you to park in visitor parking and go to the front office to get a temporary card. We will not release students to anyone who does not have a blue card.
