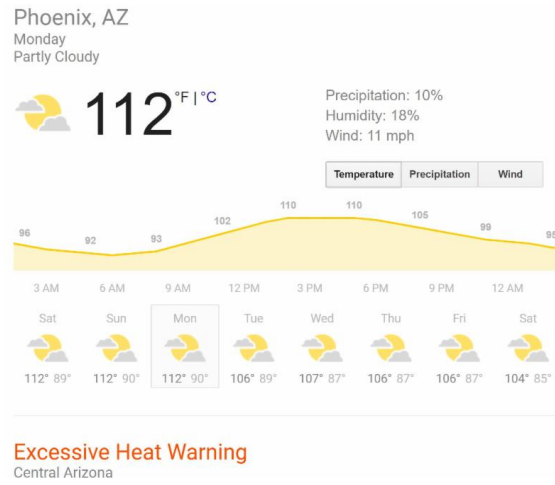

In an effort to provide greater clarity, we wanted to provide better definition regarding some of the language in the family handbook about the dress code expectations for girls. The handbook reads "Neat small bows, barrettes, headbands, and hair ties are permissible so long as they coordinate with the uniform." For our purposes small means not greater than 5 inches x 2.5 inches. The colors that coordinate with the uniform are limited to white, blue, navy blue, light blue, and burgundy. The patterns that coordinate with the uniform are limited to solid, stripes, polka dots, and plaid. We hope this alleviates some of the confusion caused by ambiguity and will bring a clearer understanding of what is permissible.
