



Headmaster letter:



Dear Archway Family and Friends,

On Wednesday I had a delightful time in our library at the Headmaster Coffee with some of our fifth- and sixth-grade parents. During our time together I shared with them some thoughts about pursuing Truth and what that might look like for our scholars, especially in the home. I also explained this year's cultural thematic goal for Archway North Phoenix – to communicate and implement a cohesive and coherent Discipline strategy. In an effort to redeem the word, *Discipline*, we are using the definition found in Charlotte Mason's *Parents and Children*[1]: the incessant watchfulness and endeavor which go to the forming and preserving of the habits of the [G]ood life. We believe that through the disciplined establishment of habits, only then can children have access to a

life that is Truly Good.

The primary mission of the school's discipline policy is to develop a structure of consistency in discipline using a proactive, preventative approach where scholars develop a respect for others, themselves, and learning. All faculty and staff are responsible for maintaining scholarly behavior. All teachers will take the necessary time to teach, model, and practice the rules. An effective ecosystem is one that reinforces positive behavior and has natural consequences for negative behavior. Children at ANP respond favorably to positive acknowledgment. Scholars are to be sent to the deans' office only if they require intensive intervention.

To equip our teachers with the tools necessary to foster this kind of atmosphere, we held a full-day Love and Logic training prior to the beginning of the school year. Each month we have a focus related to our cultural goal; August's focus was Neutralizing Student Arguing and September's will be Delayed Consequences. We will also receive ongoing support and training from the Love and Logic Institute throughout the year. If you are interested in learning more as a parent and how to implement Love and Logic techniques at home, we (in conjunction with North Phoenix Prep) will be holding Parenting with Love and Logic sessions starting in a few weeks. The cost will be \$60 per family, which includes the cost of a workbook and six classes on techniques you can use at home with any age range of kids.
