Dear Archway Family and Friends,

Last week I joined the fifth graders for lunch in the MPR. Shortly after I sat down, the young man next to me asked, "So, what do you do all day?" I chuckled, and he continued, "I think about you a lot throughout the day, and I imagine you sitting there in your office." I attempted to explain to him the nature of my role – communicating with various groups, sharing the vision and mission of the school, and helping teachers get better at becoming better teachers. "Oh," he said. "Sounds boring." I will have to work on my delivery!

Further pondering the scholar's question, much of my role consists of looking at what we do as a school, discovering areas of improvement, and then developing a plan for growth so that we continue to provide

classical education of the highest quality. Some of the tools available to me are diagnostic tools that measure student growth and can even hone in on certain standards (learning objectives) that may be lacking or not fully developed.

In order to best serve our scholars in some of these areas, we will begin providing weekly links in the newsletter for grades 2-6 that provide additional resources that can be utilized at home (under the Partnering with Parents section). Many of these provide video lessons and practice problems. This is not to say that these topics are not or have not been covered by their own teacher, but rather these are auxiliary resources that may provide the instruction in a slightly different way and/or reinforce challenging concepts.

The suggested resources are quick to use and will be beneficial for all scholars. Those who may be struggling as well as those who may need a little extra challenge can see improvement by weekly completing the suggested activities for their grade level. We invite you to partner with us by taking advantage of these free resources that we believe can make a difference in building confidence in your scholar and help deepen their understanding.
