Back to School Checklist



Textbook Deposit

One-time deposit of \$150 for new students ONLY

A one-time book deposit of \$150 is required upon enrollment to the school and is refunded when the student graduates or withdraws from the school as long as all textbooks have been returned in good condition each year.



Grade Level Supply List

In order to do well at school, your student must be prepared with the proper tools. Supply lists are available for each grade level on our website. Families may purchase school supplies from whichever vendor they choose. Please bring the supplies to your student's homeroom once your student begins classes.



Consumable Workbooks

Annual contribution, cost varies by grade level

Your child's class will utilize workbooks, writing and marking in them extensively. While we ask that parents consider contributing to offset the cost of these consumable workbooks that have to be purchased each year, a full set of workbooks will be provided to all students during the first week of school. Literature Library

Annual purchase, cost varies by grade level and vendor

Your child's class will utilize these "classics to keep" during the upcoming school year. Parents and students are strongly encouraged to purchase these books for their own personal collections, so that they can mark them and keep them, allowing students to develop their own impressive personal library of classics over the course of their academic career with Great Hearts.

For families who do not purchase the texts, their student will be given access to a copy of these books as part of their curriculum. Students should not mark these books and will be asked to return the books in good condition once their class has finished working with them.



Field Trips & Enrichment Fee

Annual contribution, \$25 per student

Each grade level has the opportunity to go on two field trips per school year. Trips vary from year to year and have included the AZ Science Museum, the Phoenix Zoo, the Desert Botanical Garden and Mesa Arts Center.

We also bring enrichment programs to campus, including Hampstead Stage Copmpany, the Herpetological Society and "George Washington." Contributions can be made online at the Payment Portal.

Tax Credit Drive
