Boonli, The Hot Lunch Program

Boonli is open again, so be sure to get your lunch orders in each Friday by 12:00pm, Noon for the following week!

Morning Late Drop-Off

Late drop-off will no longer be located at the walk-up gate. As of Monday, February 13th, it will be moved to our North lobby location (same place drop off is located in the morning and for pickup). Remember that our scholars are expected to be unpacked and seated in their rooms when the bell rings at 8:00 am. When your scholar is late, they miss valuable instruction time.

We are finding that there is a significant increase in late students daily. This week alone, we had 98 late students in ONE day at the walk-up gate, and on another day this week, we had 64.

Once a scholar has eight tardies, we will send a letter home. Repeated late scholars will receive a phone call at home from Ms. Kirby.

Hearn Street: It has been brought to our attention that ANP scholars and parents are dangerously using Hearn Street. Parents are using Hearn street to do U-turns, which endangers our Prep drivers and scholars crossing the road. ANP scholars are being dropped off on Hearn Rd. and are almost being hit while crossing the street. Please use our ANP drop-off lanes. They are in place for the safety of our parents, scholars, and staff.

Galileo Testing
