Also included, is the field trip & enrichment fee. This provides each student an opportunity to attend two field trips per school year. Trips vary from year to year and have included the AZ Science Museum, the Phoenix Zoo, the Desert Botanical Garden and the Musical Instrument Museum. We also bring enrichment programs to campus. Examples include Hampstead Stage Company, the Herpetological Society and "George Washington."
