The progress report is a wonderful tool to provide insightful data about your child's progress in the classroom. It will offer a snapshot of their academic achievements and areas of improvement. However, it is important to remember that while progress reports provide us with a glimpse into their educational journey, we also recognize the importance of viewing your child as a multifaceted individual. At Great Hearts we believe in celebrating their accomplishments beyond just grades or test scores. Additionally, you are able to continue monitoring your child's success by checking the graded work folder that is sent home each Thursday as well as watching for daily missing assignment emails to help keep your child caught up if they fall behind.

We are happy to announce that signing the Family Handbook will be done electronically this year through the Great Hearts Enrollment Parent Portal, making it more convenient and reducing the amount of paper needing to be printed. This is required of all families. To complete the process of signing, please follow the steps below:

- Please log into the Great Hearts Enrollment/Parent Portal using your username and password. If you do not remember your log-in information, please click on the Forgot Password and follow the instructions.
- Once you have logged into the enrollment system, scroll down and you will see a large box that says, Arizona Family Handbook.
- In the Arizona Academy Family Handbook section, please click on the blue "Family Handbook Link and E-Sign" button.
- For each child, please click the blue Show Application button then the green. Review and E-Sign Family Handbook for the handbook link.
- Once you review the handbook, navigate back to the Enrollment Parent Portal, accept and sign with your electronic signature.
- After you accept and hit NEXT, you will receive an email confirmation to the email registered in the enrollment system.
- Please complete the above steps for each student. If you experience any technical difficulties, please contact our registrar, Ms. Williams.

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, & Friday: ARCHWAY use both lanes until 3:20pm, then must be in ARCHWAY only lanes so PREP traffic is not blocked.

Morning Study Club!

We appreciate your patience with the new drop-off times. While this change has been challenging in adjusting to our new traffic flow, it has been beneficial for the scholars and school culture to start the day with a calm academic mindset. To support parents who need to arrive to work early, we will offer a morning Study Club beginning this coming Tuesday, September 5th, from 7:05am-7:40am. At Study Club, scholars will be in the MPR and are free to do homework, read books or study for tests. Scholars will remain in the MPR the entirety of the club. This is not intended to serve as a morning recess, but rather a safe place for scholars to be prior to 7:40am drop off. You will enter off Hearn Road, drive north along the front of the school, and drop off your scholar at the walk-up gate prior to exiting from the northernmost exit. Families are welcome to register for the Monday and Wednesday option, the Tuesday and Thursday option, or both. We will see how things go for second semester whether a Friday option is needed. This club will run until Winter Break.

An unexcused absence of 10 consecutive days will automatically result in the withdrawal of the student. TARDINESS

Students who arrive after 8am will be considered tardy and will check in at the north doors until 8:20am with Coach Norris. After that, the parent/guardian must sign the student in at the front office on arrival. Persistent tardiness is highly disruptive of instruction and undermines student morale. On the 5th occasion of an unexcused tardy in a quarter we notify the parents. If the student continues to accumulate tardies, Headmaster Kirby will be in touch to discuss possible concerns.

EARLY STUDENT PICK UP

Students that need to be picked up early for appointments must be picked up in the main office no later than 2:30pm on full days, 1:00pm on early release days, and 11:30 on half days. We do not release students the last 1/2 hour of class.

PLACARD FOR PICK UP

Blue Placards are required every day for every pick up. If lost or need a copy for any reason, please bring your ID to the front office and we can provide a new copy.

Great Hearts and Archway North Phoenix continue to utilize the system School Messenger for emails, robo calls, and text messaging to inform families of campus related academy emergencies and other communications. SchoolMessenger has a new automatic opt-in for text feature. During the registration or your re-enrollment process families confirmed their participation in text communication. Great Hearts will now automatically opt in contact information given during the registration/re-enrollment process with the options you selected. You will notice at the beginning of July you will be opted in for text messaging. If you would like to opt out of text messages simply reply STOP to the text from 67585. You can also enter the code 67585 with the message STOP to block any text messaging. Please note, if opting out, you will not receive texts regarding emergencies on campus.
