Beginning next academic year, we will transition from offering French to Spanish instruction in these grades.

This decision reflects our commitment to the mission of a classical education, which seeks to cultivate wisdom and virtue in our students by introducing them to the best of what has been thought, written, and spoken across time and cultures. Language learning is integral to this mission, as it sharpens the intellect, broadens cultural understanding, and equips students with tools for lifelong learning.

Spanish, as a widely spoken and culturally rich language, complements the classical model by offering opportunities to explore significant historical, literary, and cultural connections to the Western tradition. This transition is not meant to diminish those efforts but to refocus our resources on a language that will best serve our students in the long term, both academically and practically.

Our foreign language philosophy at Archway North Phoenix emphasizes exposing students to the discipline and beauty of language study at an early age, cultivating skills that prepare them for the rigorous study of Latin in later grades. Spanish will continue to develop our students' understanding of grammar, vocabulary, and syntax while fostering an appreciation for diverse cultures and their contributions to the classical tradition.



#### ESS Records

Special Education records (including placement records, final enrollment in referrals, evaluations, testing program) are destroyed four (4) years after the fiscal year in which a student has withdrawn, transferred, or been exited from enrollment at Archway Classical Academy North Phoenix (ANP). Special Education Census records will be destroyed five (5) years after records are created or received. This year, we will be destroying the records of students who were withdrawn, transferred, or exited from enrollment at ANP in the 2018-2019 school year or earlier. If your student withdrew, transferred, or exited from ANP during or prior to the 2018-2019 school year, files will be destroyed on the last day of the 2024-25 school year, and this serves as notice. If you are a parent or student and need a copy of your student's special education records for any reason before they are destroyed (e.g., social security benefits), please contact Kerry Souza or Jean Page in the Special Education 602-996-4355 department ksouza@archwaynorthphoenix.org or <u>jpage@archwaynorthphoenix.org</u> before the destruction date.


