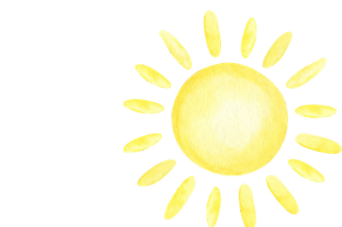
[Classroom Materials \(Consumables\)](#)

Uniform Reminder for the 2026-27 School Year

At Great Hearts schools, the student uniform is an essential part of who we are and what we do. The uniform serves to unify our students as one community of learners, irrespective of our diverse backgrounds. The uniform also signifies to the larger community our common purpose and identity as schools in pursuit of the true, the good and the beautiful. As you begin shopping for your scholar's uniforms for the upcoming school year, we kindly ask that you review the uniform guidelines outlined in the [ANP Family Handbook](#). Throughout this past year, we noticed a number of uniform compliance concerns, including socks that did not meet dress code requirements, shoes that were not entirely black or entirely white, and jewelry that exceeded the permitted limits. **To ensure consistency and uphold our school standards, uniform compliance will be a point of emphasis this fall.**

Please note the following expectations:

- Shoes must be all black or all white.
- Socks must comply with the uniform guidelines.
- Scholars may wear one bracelet, one pair of small earrings, and one simple watch.
- Smart watches are not permitted.
- Hair accessories are limited to the school's approved colors: white, navy blue, black, light blue, or maroon.
- Backpacks, lunch boxes, and water bottles should not display pop culture characters, themes, or images.
- Toys, keychains, or other decorative items should not be attached to backpacks.

We recognize that some items that did not align with our handbook expectations may have been worn during the previous years. To ensure clarity and consistency moving forward, we are providing these reminders now so families can make informed purchasing decisions before the school year begins. ANP partners with [Lands' End](#) for uniform purchases; however, families are welcome to purchase uniform items from other retailers. If purchasing from another vendor, please ensure that all items - including jumpers, skirts, pants, and shorts - closely match the style and appearance of the approved Lands' End uniform pieces.

Thank you for your partnership and support in helping our scholars present themselves with pride and professionalism each day.

Volunteer Clearance Reminders:

As this school year comes to a close and we begin to prepare for the 2026-27 school year, the Great Hearts Security Team would like to share a few reminders regarding volunteer clearance:

- 1. If you were approved to volunteer this school year, please note your application approval is valid for one-year from the date of approval. For example, an application approved on 6/1/2026 will expire on 6/1/2027.**
- 2. The Raptor system will send a reminder email 60 days prior to your application expiration date and again five days before expiration.**
- 3. If you obtained a Fingerprint Clearance card this year as part of your volunteer approval, Great Hearts still requires you to complete a new Raptor application annually based on your application expiration date. If necessary, your Fingerprint Clearance card information may be used to support approval of future applications through the card's expiration date.**
